Classes of membership and the associated subscriptions

Defined in accordance with Article 3, clause ii, of the club constitution.

The club shall have the following classes of membership:

a. Senior	An individual male or female, eighteen years of age or older on 1 January	£15
b Junior	An individual male or female, less than eighteen years of age on 1 January	£10
c. Family	Up to two adults (at least eighteen on 1st January) and any children (under eighteen on 1st January) living at the same address	£25
2. Social	Any individual wishing to be associated with the club and participate in some of its activities, but not wishing to participate in cycling events in the club's name	£10
3. Temporary	Any individual wishing to take part in a club time trial, who at the time of the event is not a first-claim or social member of the club, or of any other CTT- affiliated club	$\pounds 1$ (for the duration of the event)
All non-tomportary members are entitled to:		

All non-temporary members are entitled to: Join in the club's cycling and social activities Receive copies of the club's magazine Receive regular club news

First-claim members are additionally entitled to:

Obtain advice and coaching

- Wear club kit in competition
- Represent the club in open races and other such events
- Take part in time trials that are organised only for club members and guests
- Have a say in the way the club is run, by voting at the club's general meetings

Temporary members are exempt from the normal membership application process. Admission is at the discretion of the organiser of the event in question, subject to the constitutional non-discrimination provisions. A temporary member's sole entitlement is to take part in the club time trial for which temporary membership is acquired. His/her membership lasts only for the duration of the event.
